Please be advised that because of the proposed assignment of your service contract, you have the right under paragraph 14 of the Customer Bill of Rights to seek other carting services if you so choose.

In substance, paragraph 14 of the Customer Bill of Rights provides that your current service provider must give you at least sixty (60) days notice that your contract is being assigned to a new service provider. Such notice must be made **in writing by certified mail**.

Once you receive this written notice, you may then terminate your service contract, without penalty, by giving the service provider fourteen (14) days notice. You may give such notice to your current service provider at any time during the sixty (60) day period described above.
