

## Notice of Subcontracting

To: Westchester carting customer

Please be advised that because of the subcontracting agreement, paragraph 14 of the Customer Bill of Rights gives you the right to seek other carting services if you so choose.

In substance, paragraph 14 of the Customer Bill of Rights provides that your current service provider must give you sixty (60) days notice that your carting service is being provided by a new service provider pursuant to a subcontracting agreement. You must be given such notice **in writing by certified mail**.

Once you receive this written notice, you may terminate your service contract with \_\_\_\_\_, without penalty, by giving
