*There is also a town library tax, which applies to the entire town except the Village of Croton-on-Hudson. The taxable assessed Value is 88,526,816 and the tax rate is 6.63.

Please note that the general town tax rate is charged throughout a town including villages, if any. The unincorporated tax rate is charged in town areas outside of villages in towns that have villages. Therefore, if you live in the unincorporated area of a town that has villages you must add the two rates together to compute your total tax rate.
